- 二、依據世界貿易組織(WTO)防衛委員會本年1月24日公告，印尼依據WTO防衛協定第12.1(C)條規定通知，將對旨案產品(印尼稅則號列8418.99.10)自本年1月11日起課徵為期3年之防衛稅，各年稅率如下：
 - (一)第1年(2020年1月11日至2021年1月10日)：17%。
 - (二)第2年(2021年1月11日至2022年1月10日)：15.5%。
 - (三)第3年(2022年1月11日至2023年1月10日)：14%。
- 三、因我國產品於印尼進口市占率係屬微量，爰印方依據防衛協定第9.2條規定，將我國列入開發中國家名單，排除適用旨案防衛措施。

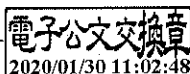

Evaporators

The following communication, dated 24 January 2020, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of Indonesia.

Pursuant to Article 12.1(c) of the WTO Agreement on Safeguards, the Government of the Republic of Indonesia hereby notifies the issuance of Minister of Finance's Regulation Number 1/PMK.010/2020* dated 6 January 2020, promulgated in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 3 on 6 January 2020 regarding the imposition of a safeguard measure on the importation of evaporators, for a period of 3 years started on 11 January 2020.*

1 GENERAL BACKGROUND

On 17 October 2019 the Republic of Indonesia notified the findings of safeguard investigation in which it was concluded that there was an evidence that the increased of volume of imports have caused a threat of serious injury to the domestic industry concerned in this investigation (G/SG/N/8/IDN/22 - G/SG/N/10/IDN/22).

It was also indicated in the notification that the Investigating Authority was proposing to the Government of the Republic of Indonesia the imposition of a safeguard measure on the importation of the subject goods.

2 DESCRIPTION OF THE SUBJECT GOODS

The description of the subject goods are as follows:

"Evaporator in a type of roll-bond and fin that is part of refrigerators, freezers, and other refrigerating or freezing equipment", under Indonesia Harmonized System (HS.) Code: Ex. 8418.99.10.

3 DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPOSED MEASURE

The Government of the Republic of Indonesia has decided to impose the following safeguard duty:

TIMETABLE OF THE SAFEGUARD DUTY

Period	Safeguard Duty
First year (11 January 2020 – 10 January 2021)	17%
Second year (11 January 2021 – 10 January 2022)	15,5%
Third year (11 January 2022 – 10 January 2023)	14%
