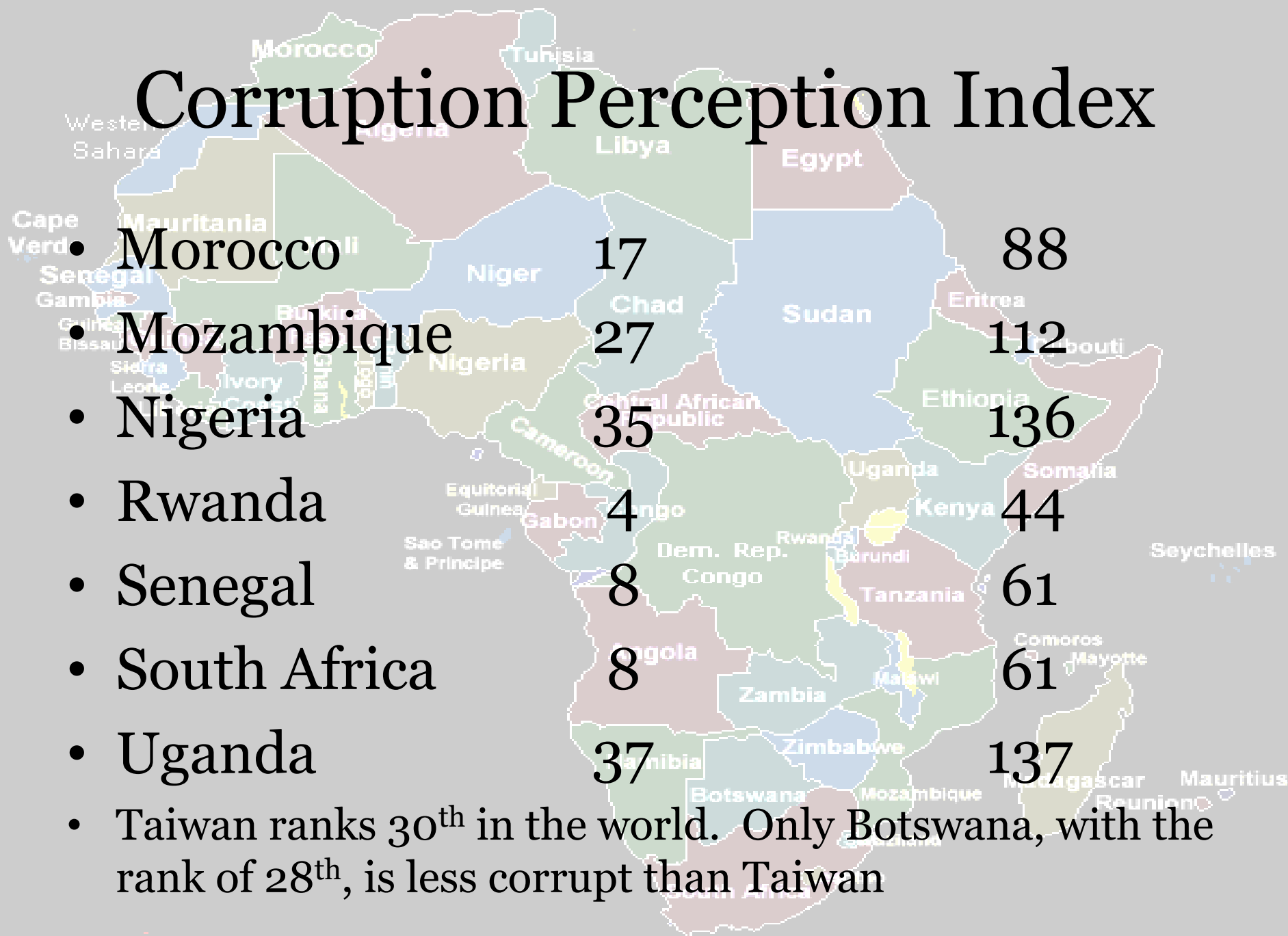


Corruption Perception Index



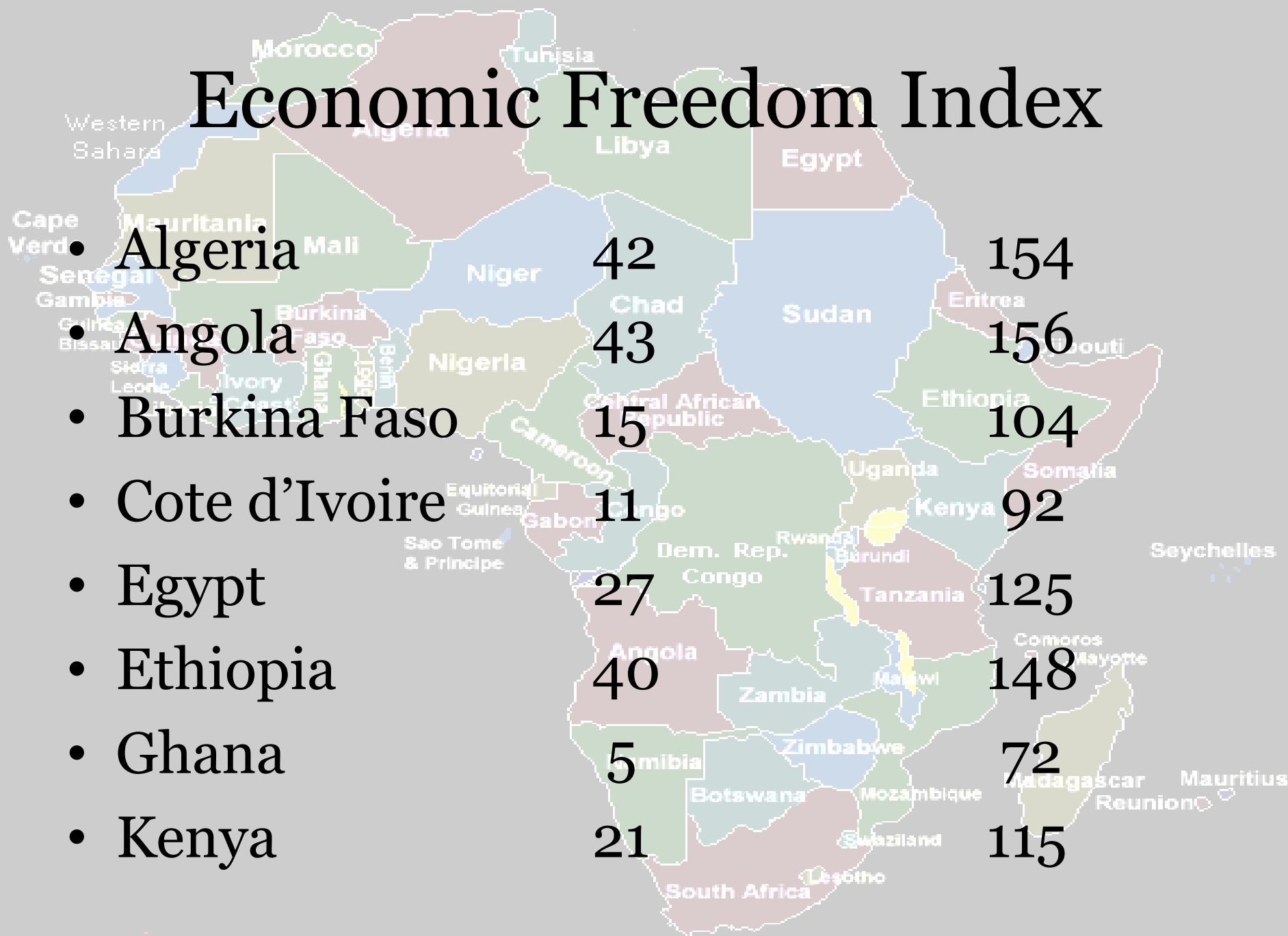
