- 2. I understand that the primary intention of a working holiday maker is to holiday in Taiwan, R.O.C. and work is incidental to supplement the holiday fund.
- 3. If I am issued the visa, I will not undertake employment for more than 3 months with one employer or work for the full twelve months of the visit.
- 4. **I am aware that R.O.C.citizens ever registered with household in Taiwan shall be subject to the laws of the Republic of China while in its jurisdiction. ★According to the Regulations for Exit of Draftees Article 14: For a draftee having maintained his household registration in Taiwan and has at the same time the status of dual nationalities shall enter into and depart from Taiwan by presenting his ROC passport; any draftee entering into Taiwan by presenting a foreign passport and is duly subject to conscription shall be restricted from departing from Taiwan.
